HOW TO GET TO HEAVEN?

Discipleship Level 1

WHO IS A SINNER?

Romans 3:13 "For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;"

Sin: wrong doing, like lying, stealing, disobedience, ect

Romans 3:10 "As it is written, There is none righteous, no, not one:"

The first thing we must realize is that we are all sinners.

WHAT IS THE PRICE OF SIN?

Romans 5:12 "Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned:"

Romans 6:23 "For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord."

Revelation 21:8 "But fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is the second death."

The price for sin is death. Not just physical death, but spiritual death.

WHO PAID FOR OUR SIN?

Romans 6:23 "For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord."

Romans 5:8 "But God commendeth his love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us."

John 3:16 "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life."

John 14:6 "Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me."

Christ paid for our sins by his death of the cross and then rising from the grave three days later.

WHAT ARE THE PROOFS OF BEING A CHRISTIAN?

I John 1:6-7 "If we say that we have fellowship with him, and walk in darkness, we lie, and do not the truth: But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin."

HE WILL DESIRE TO WALK WITH GOD

John 4:20-21 "If a man say, I love God, and hateth his brother, he is a liar: for he that loveth not his brother whom he hath seen, how can he love God whom he hath not seen? And this commandment have we from him, That he who loveth God love his brother also."

HE WILL LOVE OTHER CHRISTIANS

I Peter 2:2 "As newborn babes, desire the sincere milk of the word, that ye may grow thereby?"

HOW TO KNOW FOR SURE YOU ARE GOING TO HEAVEN

Discipleship Level 1

REVIEW OF HOW TO GET TO HEAVEN

1. Realize you are a sinner
Romans 3:23 "For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;"
2. Realize there is a price for sin
Romans 6:23 "For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord."
3. Realize Christ paid for our sins by his death on the cross
Romans 5:8 "But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us."
4. Realize the only way to heaven is through the death, burial and resurrection of Christ.
John 14:6 "Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me."

CAN WE KNOW FOR SURE WE ARE REALLY SAVED?

I John 5:13 "These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that ye may know that ye have eternal life, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God."

CAN I LOSE MY SALVATION?

John 10:28-29 "And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand. My Father, which gave them me, is greater than all; and no man is able to pluck them out of my Father's hand."

Romans 8:38-39 "For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord."

WHAT REALLY IS BAPTISM?

Discipleship Level 1

REVIEW OF CAN YOU LOSE YOUR SALVATION

We can know for sure we are saved.

I John 5:13 "These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that ye may know that ye have eternal life, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God."

We cannot lose our salvation

John 10:28-29 "And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand. My Father, which gave them me, is greater than all; and no man is able to pluck them out of my Father's hand."

We should show proofs of salvation

Psalm 63:1 "O God, thou art my God; early will I seek thee: My soul thirsteth for thee My flesh longeth for thee in a dry and thirst land, where no water is;

Seek God early before you get distracted!

PRACTICAL TIPS FOR BIBLE READING

1. Have a Bible Reading Plan
2. Seek God early in the day
3. Get in a quiet place free of distraction
4. Don't just read as a duty, read to get something from the Scripture.
5. Write down one thing you got from your reading for that day.

HOW WE SHOULD THING ABOUT MONEY

Matthew 6:19-20 19 "Lay not up for yourselves treasures upon earth, where moth and rust doth corrupt, and where thieves break through and steal: 20 But lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust doth corrupt, and where thieves do not break through nor steal"

I Timothy 6:6-8 6 "But godliness with contentment is great gain. 7 For we brought nothing into this world, and it is certain we can carry nothing out. 8 And having food and raiment let us be therewith content"

I Timothy 6:9-12 "But they that will be rich fall into temptation and a snare, and into many foolish and hurtful lusts, which drown men in destruction and perdition. 10 For the love of money is the root of all evil: which while some coveted after, they have erred from the faith, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows. 11 But thou, O man of God, flee these things; and follow after righteousness, godliness, faith, love, patience, meekness"

HOW TO SHARE YOUR FAITH?

II Corinthians 4:5 "For we preach not ourselves, but Christ Jesus the Lord; and ourselves your servants for Jesus' sake"

I Corinthians 9:16 "For though I preach the gospel, I have nothing to glory of: for necessity is laid upon me; yea, woe is unto me, if I preach not the gospel"
