

William was Willing


At age 16, William Whiting Borden was given a chaperoned trip around the world. On this trip he developed a desire to be a missionary and surrendered his life to serve Christ. He started prayer groups in school and was known for being completely devoted to the Lord. He originally wanted to be a missionary to the Muslims in northwestern China but decided to study Islam and Arabic in Cairo, Egypt first. He lived with a Syrian family



while in Cairo to learn the language and as much about their culture as possible. William was willing to live for Christ and share the gospel with people in great need, but sadly, in 1913 he contracted a disease that took him to Heaven. He was only 25 years old and never made it to the mission field but he pushed to the end. He was known for writing, "No reserves, no retreats, no regrets." When he died, a large amount of money was given to missions in China continuing his influence on the world. William was willing to give it all for Jesus! Are you?

Take me out to the Ball Game!


America's favorite pass time? I do not think so! The Dominican Republic lives for baseball.







Explore West Africa

With Livingstone the Elephant

Livingstone the Elephant is excited to continue his adventure with you as you explore what life is like for the 380 million people that live in West Africa! One very important aspect of their lives is religion. The religions in West Africa are very diverse, but there is one thing that links them all: they are deceiving people and leading them to Hell. That is why it is so important that we share with them the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Here are some of the religions that people follow in West Africa:

Islam

The most common religion in West Africa is Islam. It is followed by about 70% of the population (over 250 million people!) and is the fastest growing religion in West Africa. Muslims believe that the prophet, Muhammad, delivered the truth from Allah in the form of the Koran. Islam is a religion built upon doing enough good works; like washing, praying, giving money, and fasting. They hope that if they do enough good works, Allah might let them into Heaven. Sadly, they do not know that there are no good works they could do that would get them to Heaven. The only way to Heaven is by believing on Jesus Christ and the sacrifice He made on Calvary.



Animism


Animism is the name given to the traditional religions in West Africa that have been practiced for thousands of years. A big aspect of animism is worshiping nature. People sacrifice and pray to sacred crocodiles, catfish, and hippos. They believe that the spirits of their ancestors live inside these animals and are there to help them. They put all of their faith in the hope that these mystical animals and their ancestors will deliver them. As they worship creation, they completely miss the Creator who came to earth to die for their sins.



Christianity

There are two main groups of Christians in West Africa: the Catholics and the Charismatics. Neither of these groups usually preach the truth of the Gospel. Rather, they tell people that their good works are going to save them. A lot of these churches preach what is called the prosperity gospel, which is a lie that tells people God will make them rich. As they try to live good lives and get rich, they miss the most important treasure of all: salvation in Jesus.

People may claim they are Christian, but it does not mean they are saved. They need to put their faith in Jesus alone for salvation!

Following in their steps: David Livingstone

Did you wonder where Livingstone the Elephant got his name from? He is named after one of the most well known missionaries in Africa, David Livingstone. David was born in 1813 in Scotland. He was born into a poor family and had six siblings. When he was ten years old, he had to go work in a cotton mill to help support his family. But even after working 14 hour shifts, he would still spend hours reading and studying.

As a young man, he met a missionary to South Africa named Robert Moffat. Robert helped David Livingstone understand the great need in Africa and the difference he could make. When he was 27 years old, he arrived in South Africa to serve God as a missionary. For the next 33 years, David Livingstone would shape how the World viewed Africa.



Many people during that time thought that the interior of Africa was one huge desert where few people lived. But by exploring and facing great danger, including getting attacked by a lion, Livingstone would prove to the world that the interior of Africa was full of millions of souls that needed to hear about Jesus Christ. Even though he did not see many converts during his life, he knew that by exploring and mapping out the interior of Africa, he was paving the way for future missionaries to come spread the Gospel. He once said, "Although I see few results, future missionaries will see conversions following every sermon. May they not forget the pioneers who worked in the thick gloom with few rays to cheer, except such as flow from faith in the precious promises of God's Word."

Aside from exploring the interior of Africa and spreading the Gospel as he went, Livingstone also fought against the slave traders, who would kidnap Africans to sell them into slavery. He would raid their camps, freeing any slaves he found. He wrote many letters and books that got spread throughout England, helping people to realize that slavery was terrible and that God loved everyone regardless of the color of their skin. Both his explorations and fights against the slavers brought great dangers. But Livingstone knew that his God was greater than his enemies. He once said, "If we wait till we run no risk, the gospel will never be introduced into the interior!" He reminds us of how God can do great things with our lives when we have the faith to obey Him!

ALL ABOUT INDIA

WILLIAM CAREY

“Expect great things from God; Attempt great things for God.”

In the late 1700s in England lived a man named William Carey. While working as an apprentice in a shoe repair shop, William Carey was saved and his desire to know more about God and His word grew greatly. Although, he was not very educated, Carey began borrowing books and learning New Testament Greek. As Carey’s knowledge of God’s great love began to grow, so did his desire to tell what Jesus Christ had done for him with people who had never heard before.

Other people didn’t share in this same excitement that William Carey felt. He was left with no other option. He knew that others needed to hear the gospel and knew that if he did not tell them, they might never hear. So, Carey, along with his family and one fellow missionary, set sail for the country of India. Not knowing what would await them when they arrived, Carey continued to live out the words that he had spoken above, “Expect great things from God; Attempt great things for God.”



William Carey’s journey and first several years in India were not easy. He experienced illness, his fellow missionary abandoned him, his son died, and his wife became very sick as well. Although the circumstances were not the greatest, Carey continued to believe God and His word. Over the next several decades, William Carey began to see God do all the things that he believed God would do.

By the time William Carey died in 1834, he had spent 41 years in India. Over that time, William Carey had worked to translate the Bible into Bengali and many other languages found in India today. He was able to see hundreds come to know Jesus Christ as their Savior, founded a Bible college and much more. William Carey’s life and work has influenced untold numbers of people around the world and, even today, over 200 years later, we see the fruit of a man that expected great things from God and attempted great things for God.



What do you think would have happened if William Carey had not gone to India when people told him he shouldn’t go? What would have happened if he would have quit when bad things were happening in his life? Maybe God has put in your heart to do something great for the Lord one day. Are you expecting great things from God? If so, are you willing, like William Carey, to attempt great things for God?





DID YOU KNOW?

KNOWN AS ONE OF THE MOST POPULAR TOURIST ATTRACTIONS IN ALL OF INDIA AND ONE OF THE SEVEN WONDERS OF THE WORLD, THE TAJ MAHAL IS THE TOMB FOR THE WIFE OF MUGHAL EMPEROR SHAH JAHAN. THE EMPEROR HAD THIS ELABORATE STRUCTURE BUILT SPECIFICALLY FOR HIS WIFE AFTER SHE DIED GIVING BIRTH TO THEIR FOURTEENTH CHILD. THE BODIES OF SHAH JAHAN AND HIS WIFE LIE BENEATH THE WORLD FAMOUS STRUCTURE.

TAJ MAHAL FACTS

Fact #1: It took approximately 22 years, 20,000 workers, 1,000 elephants, and close to one billion dollars to build the Taj Mahal.

Fact #2: There is a widely held belief that after completion, the architect and workers were either killed or their hands were removed so they could never create such a beautiful structure, like the Taj Mahal again. However, many researchers say that there isn't enough evidence to support this claim.

Fact #3: The environment around the Taj Mahal is affecting the structure. Over the years, due to smog, the Taj Mahal has a yellow tinge. The ground beneath the Taj Mahal has begun to decay as well and scientists believe that the Taj Mahal could soon collapse.

There are real spirits in the world, but what Lulu and her friends and her mom don't know is that there is only one true God!


The Bible tells us all about God and His Son, Jesus, and how we need to trust in Him to be saved from our sins. Lulu and her mom don't have a Bible.

Fireworks are fun and exciting! Here's how you can make your own with water!

1



Fill a glass container with warm water leaving an inch or so for the oil to be added later

You will Need:

- Warm water •
- Oil (any cooking oil) •
- Food coloring (with dropper) •
- Glass container •
- Small cup •
- Fork •

2



Add oil to a small cup (a few table spoons)

3



Add a few drops of coloring to the oil (only about 2 drops per color with 2-3 colors)

4



Lightly stir oil with a fork to break up coloring

5



Gently pour in the oil so that it layers on top of the water with the coloring drop suspended in the oil

6



Watch your fireworks experiment display!
